Building Connections Beyond the Classroom**

A Burlington County Education Association Member:

- who goes above and beyond the curriculum to engage the students
- who promotes community activities and broadens the students' horizons and interests outside the classroom setting
- who connects the students to their community with their knowledge of, commitment to and engagement in an activity or group. By doing so, community support of the school district increases.

A current student or graduate of a Burlington County Public School:

- who has been or is currently in a leadership role with a team, activity or group outside of the classroom
- who is goal oriented in promoting their team, activity or group with the community.
- who is respected by their school and community

A Burlington County School Administrator or Community Member:

- who is a supporter of student growth through extra-curricular activities
- who is respected by the entire educational community.
- who recognizes the importance of a well-rounded student and supports student involvement outside the classroom

An Elected Official: (local, county, state or federal level)

- who is a strong supporter of public education and student involvement in extracurricular activities
- who is visible and accessible to the public school community
- who is a key to empowering change or transforming the community support for public education.
- who has track record of actions that show support of public education
